### TWO CRISES, ONE MISSION

- Climate change + economic exclusion = Injustice against God's natural creation (clean air) & God's human creation (sustainable quality of life) for urban communities.
- Black and Brown communities face the intersectionality of ecological neglect and job exclusion.

#### PLAYBOOK - BIBLICAL GROUNDING

- "The Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to till it and keep it." — Genesis 2:15 (NRSV)
- In our current cultural context: not family but defending and advancing as a team (i.e., football team).
- Black liberation + ecological theology = a new playbook for justice.





#### <u> HUDDLE – TOUCHDOWNS (AGREED PERCEPTIONS)</u>



 Divestment in public education of math & science training causes economic exclusion from ecological science and green market advances.



 Lack of corporate development investment in Black/ Brown communities. The church can be a partner with local leadership and advocates to highlight our community resources and talent pool.



• Divestment in Black/ Brown community infrastructure continues to fuel land abandonment and building deterioration. This waste does not serve creation economically nor ecologically.



#### HUDDLE — TIME-OUTS (DIFFERENT PERCEPTIONS TO REVISIT)



• There is little sense of urgency for environmental issues in the Black/ Brown community. Daily survival and individualism are priority. A paradigm shift will be needed - nature can survive without humans; humans cannot survive without nature.



 Traditional theology in the Black/ Brown community has fueled misunderstanding our human role in God's creation and the generational traditions of our ancestors who honored nature.




 We are ignorant of Black/ Brown contributions to science, math and technology in this world. Re-tooling and re-education is needed to highlight our abilities.


